School Lunches

All our meals must meet the Statutory Nutritional Standards and our kitchen staff, led by Donna Evans, take care of this. Lunches are provided on a menu system that gives the children daily choice and therefore cuts down on wastage. Menus are issued on a 3 week rolling program and are therefore currently set until February. Menus are available to view on the school website. Key Stage One children are now all eligible for universal free school meals.

Parent Pay: We are working to becoming a cashless school. The majority of payments for trips, school dinners etc. now need to be made online using Parent Pay. If you have not set this up or need further information please contact Miss Musson in the school office.

Milk

A nutritious carton of milk is available for all the children in Reception right through to Year 6. If you have not already filled in your form requesting milk, please call into the school office and speak to Miss Dunleavy. There is a charge for the above unless your child is entitled to benefits related free school meal.

Praise Assembly

Praise Assembly usually takes place on a Friday at 3pm. This is an opportunity for us to share reward certificates and celebrate the successes of the children, including outside school awards such as swimming certificates. From **Friday 7th October** parents are welcomed back to join us in the hall for assembly, enter via the main entrance. We kindly ask that you refrain from chatting and using mobile phones during the assembly. Thank you.

Residential

If your child is in Year 4-6 you should now have received the letters regarding residentials. Reminders about payments will be made periodically and a parents meetings will be held nearer the time.
