Parents evening: is taking place on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> and Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> November. **Booking closes at 4pm on 19th October,** times will be allocated after this, currently 78% of parents have booked.

The main purpose is for you to have a short discussion about how your child(ren) has settled into their class.

We are very happy to be doing face to face parents' meetings again after 2 years of COVID, appointments are 10 minutes long and we ask that you keep to those times in order that the evening runs smoothly. With this in mind we are using the bell again to help us keep to our time slots, please respect this. There will also be someone near the door ticking you off as you arrive, please try and arrive 5 minutes before your allocated time so that you don't miss your slot.
